Denise Stewart is an OT with a three-decade interest in both lymphoedema and soft tissue therapy for cancer survivors, which has resulted in a fascination for developing clinically relevant assessments for the mix of impairments experienced by breast cancer survivors.

Denise believes that lymphoedema therapists must expand services beyond lymphoedema care to help reduce the burden of side-effects experienced by people after surviving cancer; because who else could do the job?
